About the Award

Established in 2001 by GTHL President John Gardner, the GTHL Special Recognition Award was developed to recognize those players who have displayed inspirational courage in overcoming adversity while maintaining a dedication and commitment to competing in hockey.

The Award is presented by the Greater Toronto Hockey League to GTHL players (Competitive, Select or House League) who have experienced a significant event in their lives and have managed to overcome the adversity and continued playing the game of hockey.

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

1. Eligibility

- Any currently registered player within the GTHL, Mississauga Hockey League and Scarborough Hockey Association (House League, Select or Competitive)

2. Method of Nomination

- a. Application forms will be made available in February.
- b. **March 10th is the application deadline to nominate a person.** Applications handed in after March 10th will not be accepted.

3. Method of Selection

The Awards Committee of the GTHL will make a recommendation of candidates to the GTHL Board of Directors to be the recipient of the award.
