When and Where?

The Greater Toronto Hockey League hosts this tournament from **December 27th through December 30th**. The tournament takes place at the Hershey Centre in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada.

Tournament Format

Quality is better then Quantity. A total of 20 major Peewee AAA teams will participate in the tournament. Each team plays in one of 4 divisions. The tournament consists of a round-robin format with each team being guaranteed four games. At the conclusion of the Preliminary round, the 1st and 2nd place teams in each of the four divisions advance to the Quarter-Finals.

The Game lengths will be as follows:
12-12-15 minute periods.

In Preliminary Round games, if tied at the end of regulation time, teams will play one five (5) minute stop time "SUDDEN VICTORY" overtime period 4 on 4. If still tied, the tie will stand.

Overtime in the Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Finals shall be handled as follows: If tied at the end of regulation time, teams will play ten (10) minute stop time sudden victory periods 4 on 4.
